# Réserve Tradition

Witness of respect for the tradition of the Appellation Côtes de Provence, the Cuvée Réserve is vinified and bottled at the Château du Rouët since 1936.

On this estate, established on the gravel of porphyres of the Estérel mountain range, six generations of wine-makers have transmitted their skill and passion of the terroir.

The ancestral grape-varieties, the specificity of the soil, the experience of generations, harmonise in this cuvée, to transmit typicity and character.

## Tasting



### Cuvée Réserve Red

*Pronounced red colour complex on the nose. Red fruits and spice, a round palate on melted tannins. Powerful on the finish, great expression of the typicity of the terroir.*



### Cuvée Réserve Rosé

*Delicate salmon coloured wine. Intensive notes of raspberry and cassis on the nose. Fresh, fruity and elegant flavours on the palate. Volume and length.*



### Cuvée Réserve White

*Enticing floral and mineral notes on the nose. Round fresh palate. Excellent expression of the typicity Provençal.*

In the last ten years the wines "Château du Rouët" have obtained 22 medals at the Concours Général Agricole in Paris, as well as the Concours des Grands Vins de France in Mâcon, notably 6 gold medals and 4 silver medals. At the Concours des Vinalies Nationales (Union of Oenologists of France) 10 distinctions have been awarded.
