Born 1850, in Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert, Martin Sevérac leaves his native Hérault, to travel between Rhône and the Ocean. His descendants inherited, his great passion for vines and wine, who later implanted old vine - plants, conserved in the family vines in Aniane (Hérault), into their vineyard in the Provence (le Muy).

Small yield. Classical wine - making of three weeks, with punching of the cap and pumpingover. Maturing in 500 and 220 liter barrels

Dark garnet - red colour with purple-blue reflection. A deep, intensive nose, reserving an extraordinary explosion of aromas. Aroma of violets, peonies and black currant. On the palate intensive, harmonious tannins.
